Old Fella volunteers Sandy McFeat, Nikki Jones and Rachel Phillips did a series of presentations to the students at Center for New Beginnings on the responsibilities of caring for a companion animal.

The presentations mark the second year Old Fella's humane educators have been able to reach out to students at the Center. Our educators met with a total of 15 students, ranging in age from 3 to 19. After learning about proper animal care, cruelty prevention, spay/neuter services and pet adoption, each student received coloring books, a copy of the [Kind News](#), bookmarks and other educational materials.

Also, the students met and handled "George" and "Ringo," two Old Fella foster puppies who were transported on a Dixie Dog transport to Massachusetts on August 7, 2009.

Old Fella's educators plan to return to the Center for New Beginnings around the Christmas holiday to visit the students again.

Sandy, one of Old Fella's primary humane educators, makes regular visits the elementary classrooms all around Burke County to deliver Old Fella's message of compassion and responsibility for our Burke County companion animals.
